Videos will be submitted for review and will be judged based on effectiveness in addressing healthy relationship choices and the impact of technology on dating. A monetary prize will be provided to the top 3 videos selected (**\$500** for first; **\$300** for second; **\$200** for third). Special consideration will be given to videos that address online and digital aspects of healthy relationships. However, videos all forms of relationships are encouraged.

Official Rules and Submission form for the Florida Art Therapy Association (FATA) Focusing on Healthy Dating Video Project

Parental Permission must be provided for participants under age 18.

Please sign and date the form on page 5 acknowledging that you have read and agree to the terms and conditions of the FATA Focusing on Healthy Dating video project.

General Terms:

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- Videos submitted to the FATA Focusing on Healthy Dating video project should be no longer than one minute, or **60 seconds**, in length. Videos longer than this requirement will automatically be disqualified from the contest.
- Video submission contestants **MUST** also complete a short 5 question quiz regarding healthy teen dating facts at <https://testmoz.com/222607>. Contestants should enter their **full name** in the Student Login to access and complete the quiz.
- Videos submitted for review will be judged based on the effectiveness of addressing healthy relationship choices and the impact of technology on dating violence.
- Videos submitted **must** have a **live link** where the video can be viewed by judges. They may be posted on a website of the contestants choosing, for example Vine, Instagram, or Youtube.
- Videos should address themes based on the following information regarding healthy relationships:

How do you know if you have a healthy relationship?

1. **Your relationship is healthy if...**
2. You trust each other.
3. You respect and not criticize your partner's beliefs, opinions, and thoughts.
4. You both feel safe in the relationship.
5. You each enjoy spending time separately, with your own friends, as well as with each other's friends.
6. You have equal decision-making power.
7. You don't have to make excuses for your partner's behavior.
8. You and your partner like each other for who you are.
9. You feel comfortable sharing your opinions, even when they differ from your partners.
10. You don't have to spend every moment with your partner. You each enjoy doing things together, as well as separately.
11. You have close family and friends who like your partner and are happy about your relationship.
12. You never feel like you're being pressured for sex or to do anything sexual.
13. Your partner respects your privacy and doesn't go through your cell phone, mail, email, or social networking site profiles.
14. Your partner does not call or text you constantly to see where you are, who you are with and what you are doing.

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15. You always treat each other with respect.

5. FATA will take screen shots/ still frames from the top 20 videos submitted and provide honorable mentions to the creators of those videos. FATA will print photos of those still frames and host art shows throughout Florida in local galleries, agencies and museums. We will have a minimum of 5 openings to debut the videos and images, and provide an informal presentation at the openings regarding domestic violence prevention.
6. FATA does not claim ownership of any Video submitted to the project users and unless other specified, you hereby grant FATA, a irrevocable, perpetual, and fully sub-licensable license to use worldwide, royalty-free and non-exclusive license, to use, distribute, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, translate, publicly perform and publicly display the Video in whole or in

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part, and to incorporate such Video into other works in any format or medium now known or later developed for any and all commercial or non-commercial purposes.

7. You agree that by submitting Video, FATA may disclose certain information about you in connection with the submission, including your name, age, grade, school, or other general biographical information.
